ITINERARY AT A GLANCE:

October 11: Guests arrive Tabuk, Saudi Arabia.


October 12: Split Rock of Horeb, Land of the Amalekites with inscriptions. Wadi al Tayyib. Optional overnight this evening for campers wishing to climb Jabal al Lawz or Elijah's Cave.

October 13: Jabal al-Lawz, Golden Calf Altar, cemetery, Elijah's Cave. Lunch at the mountain. Late this afternoon we will visit Al-Bad' and the Well of Moses and Zipporah.

October 14: This afternoon, Elim and its twelve wells and seventy palm trees plus Magna and the Red Sea crossing site facing the land bridge to Sharm el Sheik (Egypt).

October 15: Haql (Jordanian border), the Red Sea beaches and the Red Sea crossing site across from Nuweiba Beach, Egypt. Farewell dinner.

October 16: Flights continue to your home airport.



EMBARK ON AN ANCIENT JOURNEY

The foundational narrative of the Exodus, as outlined in the second book of the Torah of Yahweh, contains some of the most vital and momentous accounts in all the Old Testament. The quest to uncover the archaeological and geological evidence of the Israelites’ liberation from Egypt, Moses’ revelation at Mt. Sinai, and the nation of Israel’s ensuing desert wanderings have captured the hearts and minds of some of history’s most brilliant scholars and explorers. Cartographers, archaeologists, scientists, adventurers, historians and disciples of all backgrounds have sought out the genuine locations as depicted in ancient manuscripts. Finally – with the advent of state-of-the-art technology and the ever-increasing political stability of the region – the Northwest corner of Arabia has begun to divulge its buried secrets.

Join author Steve Cioccolanti of Discovery Ministries on the adventure of a lifetime as he teaches his way through the geography of the past hidden Exodus route. Explore Midian, known by locals to be the home land of Jethro (the prophet named Shu’ayb) who was Moses’ father-in-law. Examine the Split Rock of Horeb at Jabal Maqla, where Moses struck the boulder and God miraculously provided water from within. Survey the Jabal al-Lawz mountain, with its charred and blackened summit, ascertained to be the original Mount Sinai which Yahweh descended upon in fire. Discover for yourself why Jewish and Bedouin traditions have continued for centuries to call this peak: “The Mountain of Moses.”

Entrance into the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is at its infancy, and group space is exceptionally limited. Due to the distinctive nature of this trip’s itinerary, please take careful note of the specific conditions for travel listed herein and as designated on the registration form.



ITINERARY IN DETAIL



October 11: Arrive in Tabuk today to begin the tour. Under the Terms and Conditions portion of this brochure are some air suggestions for those departing from Brisbane, Sydney, New York or Singapore. They are suggested itineraries only. Your only requirement is to try to arrive in Tabuk on October 11 prior to our dinner together the first night which will be at 7:00PM. This way you are well rested to begin the tour tomorrow, on October 12.

If you arrive Tabuk between 1:30PM and 6:00PM, you will be met on arrival and transferred to your hotel for dinner. If you arrive outside of those hours, you will take a taxi to the hotel (approximately \$9USD). [D]

October 12: This morning we have a stunning drive through the Land of the Amalekites. Soon we begin some off roading (with lots of camels!), meandering through dark red windswept landscapes to arrive the majestic Split Rock of Horeb. Here, you can analyze the phenomenon with your own eyes. You can see the site from this area and how the water would have gushed out. In the ledges around the rock, you will have plenty of time to explore what may be the ancient proto-Hebraic inscriptions, images of warriors with bows and arrows, marks of feet and various other consonantal formations.

Take a rest in camp chairs for our lunch that is brought to us in this remarkable area! This is a great time of fellowship and teaching together. We will also visit Wadi al Tayyib today which is the Red Sea entrance to Elim. After a full day of exploration, those camping tonight will take specific vehicles to Jabal al Lawz for dinner and overnight.

In order to do any inclusions at Mount Sinai, you must take the optional overnight camping extension. Hiking includes any visit to the Plateau of 70 Elders, Elijah's Cave (and/or the Apostle Paul's and Moses) and the blackened top. Those not camping at the mountain will go to the Red Sea based hotel for dinner and overnight. [B/L/D]



ITINERARY IN DETAIL

October 13: Those who spent the night camping will wake up around 4:30AM to begin their journey up the mountain. Those coming from the Red Sea hotel will arrive Jabal al Lawz via road. The group is joined together for a teaching at the altar site of Jabal al Lawz. Jabal al-Lawz (meaning the almond mountain in Arabic) which is hailed as one of the most mysterious mountains (with Maqla its highest peak) in the Middle East. Most people think that Saudi Arabia is a land of vast sand dunes, but this is far from true. With its summit at 8,362 feet above sea level, Jabal al-Lawz is the highest mountain of the Tabuk Province.

Jabal al-Lawz is also considered to be the real Mount Sinai. This is where Moses received the writing of God and the covenant commandments, meeting Him in a cloud of fire scorching the mountaintop. *Please note the availability of touring this site is at its infancy and we must respect all laws at the site.*

From here you will have time to understand sacrificial areas and their relationship to Elijah's Cave and the plateau of the 70 elders above. As a group we will visit the compelling Golden Calf Altar with its Egyptian "calf" markings and be able to see the standing stones of the ancient cemetery – dated to Moses' time. There is another significance brewing around the mountain that is modern day. The artificial intelligence geographical area called NEOM will soon be centered over the top of Jabal Al Lawz. Seeing it in its natural state prior to the build-out is a unique opportunity. Be sure to research this new man-made project.

After lunch at the mountain, the rest of the day is spent on the sites hailed by the Saudi's to reflect Moses and Jethro - Shu'ayb Prophet caves (Jethro's Caves), the well of Moses and Zipporah. Al-Bad' is located in the Wadi 'Afal - a wide 31-mile valley that connects the Levant (Lebanon, Jordan,



Palestine) to the western shore of Arabia. Most scholars agree that Al Bad' is the ancient city of Madyan (Midian). Madyan, which refers to both a land and a city, dates back to the end of the 2nd millennium BCE.

Madyan is known for being the place where Moses originally sought refuge after fleeing from Egypt. This is where he met the Priest of Midian - Jethro - who recognized Moses' pure heart and gave Moses one of his daughters. Moses lived here for forty years with his wife and father-in-law before returning to Egypt to free his people from the Pharaoh, Ramses II. Overnight. **[B/L/D]**

ITINERARY IN DETAIL



October 14: Unique treat again today by visiting the site of Elim. We will have a four-wheel drive adventure as we come into the area of seventy palms and twelve ancient wells. The miracle of the quails and its location on the backside of Jabal al Lawz, yet beyond the Red Sea entrance is very profound. Next, we are going to head south to Magna and to the Red Sea crossing site that faces Sharm el Sheik and what is today one of the King's Palaces. Dinner and overnight. [B/L/D]

October 15: Haql – on the border of Jordan, is a very small town that is very close to the Red Sea crossing site across from Egypt's Nuweiba Beach. From here we will be able to see the sight where King Solomon marked the famous Moses crossing. Return to the hotel where we will have a farewell dinner. Some guests will fly out of Tabuk this evening at 10:15PM. [B/L/D]

October 16: Flights continue on to your home city.



OPTIONAL OVERNIGHT CAMPING ADVENTURE



October 12: Those not taking the optional camping adventure will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. Those opting for the adventure will arrive Jabal al Lawz and the fresh camp at the base of Mount Sinai as the sun is going down. If you take this option, the sun comes up on the mountain at 6:15AM. You can take in an early climb with one of the guides to Elijah's Cave, the Plateau of the 70 Elders and/or the blackened summit. It is too time consuming to try to do all 3 on the same day. The ability to make it to any altitude without overnighting at the base is very difficult, therefore the only way to make a climb to either is by taking the optional overnight camping adventure.

Folks not climbing can also take the overnight camping adventure. Those not climbing have ample time to explore and worship. Guaranteed – you will feel as though it was time well spent in awe of what has taken place at this mountain. It is very comfortable and will be an overnight of a lifetime. The tents are individual Arabian tents with carpeted floors and comfortable bedding. But, the tents are laying “on the ground”. They are not beds. There is an impressive mobile unit for showers, bathrooms and a top kitchen unit for outdoor barbeque. Evenings are around a campfire with some camp chairs, raging fire and an overhead view that would be difficult to ever repeat in a lifetime. Don't miss it if possible.

ADVENTURE EXCURSION IN ARABIA

Looking to take a more adventurous route into the wilderness? Our Saudi Arabia Adventure package offers an alternative path designed for more active tour participants!

The options below will highlight Moses' time in the land of Midian and the Exodus crossing sites. Explore the real Mount Sinai by hiking and camping along the same route Moses may have taken. Partake in classic fellowship and learning at the main sites throughout the tour but with extra time for worship, fellowship or trekking. If you enjoy an activity level that is different from your spouse or travel companion, you can select different activities. Choose the adventure that's perfect for you! The overnight is \$540 per person including a special breakfast, dinner and trekking guide (if desired).

Note that Scuba diving or snorkeling in the Red Sea will only

be available if you arrive Tabuk two or three nights early. While we will be on the Red Sea for much of the touring, the areas we will visit are primarily beach and sand. We will need to book you on a separate boat excursion to be able to dive or snorkel off the coast of Arabia. Some like to do this and investigate the crossing sites for yourself. You must have a PADI certificate to dive, or again, arrive early enough to obtain one via PADI training that we can set up on your behalf.

IMPORTANT FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA

In the past years, travel to the Kingdom was not allowed with Israeli stamps in your passport. That is no longer the case as of today. Dress is modest – it is best that you wear clothing that does not show your “shape”. Women do not need to cover their heads. Be advised that you will be fingerprinted and undergo a retinal scan upon arrival in the country. The country is undergoing a remarkable restoration and we cannot predict if a site might be under construction. Be sure to study up on the artificial intelligence operated area called NEOM. Our travels will take us into the middle area of it.

IMPORTANT TRAVEL DETAILS

Our trip is considered active on two of our days. This means that, if you choose to hike, there are two days that will offer ample time. If you are not a hiker, just know that the walking is on fairly normal surfaces. You do not need to climb up Mount Sinai or to sit inside the Split Rock of Horeb to enjoy the sites. There are some hikes, slightly more demanding walks at certain sites, or when walking to sites. This includes a few elevations, a comfortable but busy schedule, some long drives in comfortable Land Cruisers – which can be a bit bumpy.

Our lodging is in a 4 star Saudi hotel in Tabuk, and if permitted one of the nights at a Red Sea Resort, although the government is the one to allow it. You also have a choice to spend one night in a camp set up specifically for our group that is comfortable, but is tent camping. All the services meet our high standards, and you will be very comfortable and well pleased. We obtain a visa on your behalf approximately 35 days prior to departure.

Your trip includes hotels as noted, all meals and water on entire trip. It includes the 4WD transportation on the two days, and all transportation throughout the trip, all entrance fees, guiding, teaching, pre-trip materials and visa assistance. Please note that in addition to the cost of the tour, there is a visa fee and optional trip cancellation insurance that is additional. We strongly recommend trip cancellation insurance which includes medical insurance while outside of the USA and trip delay protection. Only American citizens can purchase our trip cancellation insurance.

For your convenience, we offer a travel insurance plan through Travelex Insurance Services.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Proper Documentation

All members of this tour must carry passports valid for at least six months beyond their scheduled date of return. At this time there are no Covid requirements for Saudi Arabia – no PCR tests and no injections. But, please note that things can also change. At this time, we have no way of knowing what could be implemented in the future. Please note that the vendors will have already accepted your booking knowing there is a current global threat. Therefore, if you book this tour, you are accepting the terms of the airlines, the TSA, the countries to which you are traveling and/or other governing parties without fully knowing what they will be by the time you travel.

Air Tickets

There is an air block from New York/JFK (or you can purchase your own airfare). Airfare is not included in the tour price. The current air schedule below that you will want to match out of New York is as follows:

NEW YORK/JFK:

October 10: Saudi Air departs JFK at 2:00PM, change in Riyadh and arrive Tabuk at 1:20PM on October 11.

October 15: The return to New York is on Saudi Air and departs Tabuk at 9:15PM. Change planes in Riyadh and arrive New York/JFK at 11:55AM on October 16.

Group air cost is \$1399USD PP

Suggested air from other cities:

SYDNEY:

October 10: United Arab Emirates departs at 6:00AM, change to Fly Dubai in Dubai and arrive Tabuk at 5:45PM on October 10. We can add an additional night at the Tabuk hotel for you.

October 16: The return departs Tabuk at 6:45PM, changes again from Fly Dubai over to United Arab Emirates and arrives Sydney at 10:30PM. Approximate cost on above at time of printing in USD is \$1,575USD PP

BRISBANE:

October 10: United Arab Emirates departs at 9:00PM, change in Dubai and Riyadh. And arrive in Tabuk on October 11 at 1:15PM.

October 16: The return departs Tabuk at 6:45PM, changes from Fly Dubai Over to United Arab Emirates and arrives Brisbane at 10:20PM. Approximate cost on above at time of printing in USD is \$2,100USD PP

We will not be arranging special transfers within Saudi Arabia due to the ease and availability of airport taxis to the first night hotel. We will be arranging transfers for anyone who wants to take the arrival and departure transfer that meets the New York/JFK group air schedule.

Reissuance of tickets that must be changed or reissued for any reason, may be subject to charges or fees by the carriers and/or other vendors; such fees may be substantial. Saudi Airlines can change their air schedules at any time, and sometimes without notification. We cannot stress enough the importance of trip cancellation insurance.

Due to the current situation arising with struggling airlines we are recommending that those purchasing airline tickets including connecting flight tickets wait until 21 days prior to departure to purchase such tickets.

Limitations

The air carrier(s), group operators and LP reserve the right to substitute equipment and properties and to add or delete en route stops at our discretion with or without notice. The hotels, airlines, ground operators and other vendors used by LP reserve the right, in special circumstances, to substitute accommodations/transportation and sights of similar or better quality without penalty. This includes sites as noted on the itinerary. The KSA is in its infancy. Because of this – they can choose to do site work that can affect our visits. Minimum group size is 12, and with less than 16, the pricing may increase as high as 15%.

Singles

We match roommates! If you are a single person or traveling alone, we do have others who would like to travel with us without paying the single supplement. We assign roommates approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. We cannot guarantee it, but it has worked well for many.

Making Your Deposit / Reservations

- If depositing prior to July 30, 2022, a non-refundable deposit of \$1,500 per person is due (plus optional travel insurance) and your signed registration form. If booking after July 30, 2022 - full payment is due within 7 days of your registration. Payments not received by the due day are subject to a 5% monthly finance charge and possible cancellation of reservation.
- Please note we will continue to take bookings and reservations until our departure, as long as space is available and we will do everything possible to make sure you can join us!
- You may use a credit card for your initial deposit and optional insurance and then pay the balance with cash or check and still receive the full cash discount.

Changes / Revisions

We will try to accommodate name changes, but additional fees may be imposed and passed on by the carriers. If specific rooming requests are altered due to cancellation by one or more passengers, the passenger(s) still traveling may be required to pay the resulting applicable occupancy rate. Trip insurance may cover this additional cost.

Cancellation and Refunds

In the event that you must cancel your reservation, or payments are not received by specified deadlines, refunds are made in accordance with the following schedule. All cancellations received after booking and deposit will forfeit the \$1,500 deposit.

- 68 to 45 days prior to departure, the cancellation fee is \$2450 for the main tour per person, plus any additional costs incurred, pre- or post-options, and insurance or add on travel you have purchased.
- 44 days and less the trip becomes nonrefundable.

Please know that credits transferred from another tour are subject to the nonrecoverable costs in place at the time of transfer. These funds will remain nonrefundable. If you accept the travel insurance offered, any insurance premium paid is nonrefundable, if you have filed a claim, plan to file a claim, or have departed on your trip and subject to the terms and condition of the provider. Airfare is always non-refundable.

Responsibility

LP has the responsibility of booking with airlines, hotels, transportation vehicles, ground operators and tour guides to provide you with these services. The carriers, hotels, and other suppliers providing tour services are independent contractors and are not agents, employees, or servants of, or joint ventures with LP or its affiliates. All certificates and other travel documents for tour services issued by LP are subject to the terms and conditions specified by the supplier, and to the laws of the countries in which the services are supplied. Each participant agrees not to hold LP liable, in the absence of its own negligence, for any loss, act or omission, whether negligent or otherwise, of any person or firm which is to, or does provide goods or services for the trip and shall have no liability to the participant for the quality of services or the condition or cleanliness of accommodations or for any transportation delay, including but not limited to liability for inconvenience, shortened vacation time, additional expense, or any other kind of damage. LP is not responsible for government actions, weather, mechanical breakdowns, war, terrorism, acts of nature (secularly known as "Acts of God"), denying entrance to a site due to political or other reasons or other circumstances beyond its control. If a travel ban is imposed by the United States on any country we are scheduled to tour,

we will attempt to secure another destination. We cannot be held accountable due to political decisions. In the event of delay, the airline or tour company and not LP, determines delay procedures and the amenities/compensation, if any, to be offered. LP will not accept responsibility for additional charges incurred for expenses or lost wages as a result of changes to flight times, and/or missed vacation time.

Activities

Participants may choose to engage in various activities including, but not limited to, camel riding, hiking, swimming and other "activities"; participants are hereby notified that these and other activities may be dangerous and may result in a serious injury and that participation in these activities shall be at the participant's own risk. Living Passages (herein referred to as LP) shall not be liable for any injuries sustained by cruise/tour participants, which are a result of participant's engaging in such activities.

Travelers Who Need Special Assistance

LP must be advised of a participant's special requirements at the time of booking and we will make every effort to accommodate special requests but cannot confirm a reservation until all travel suppliers have acknowledged that they can provide the services requested.

Prepaid Tips

All tips are prepaid and distributed on your behalf throughout the tour to cover tipping for guides, drivers, etc.

Fuel Surcharges, Fees or Taxes

It is possible that the ground, vehicles, governments, visa providers or facilitators and other operators will bill LP for additional fuel surcharges, fees and or other taxes. You will be notified quickly and prior to being billed for final payment if any vendors make any of these types of increases. You may arrange your own air travel.

Currency and Special Provisions

Pricing of tour and event was based on currency that was in effect on April 10, 2022. You will be notified as far in advance as possible in the event the price of the tour needs to be adjusted. We do not foresee this happening, but in today's economic climate, we have to be prepared for any currency discontinuation or devaluation or "reset" that can affect any of the countries we visit, transit or to which we provide governance. We will do everything possible to not allow this to happen but we have to be mindful of the world's current political environment.

Safety

The safety of passengers is a primary concern of LP but also of the owners and operators of the vessels, aircraft, ground transportation, and other facilities being used. If safety is threatened by any factors the owners/operators of other facilities and services reserve the right to make whatever changes to the itinerary or schedule they deem necessary for the safety of all.

In the event of danger or war, we will do all possible to facilitate a change of dates, destinations and vendor refunds. It all depends on timing and geography. There is never a set standard of operation. In 20 years, we have never seen an entirely negative outcome for a group. But, we do live in interesting times.

In the event you choose to hike, snorkel, dive or take part in any activity, you are solely responsible to ensure that you have the capabilities to perform the activities. There will be additional Saudi emergency services that will be offered in the coming months. This is supplied by a separate company for those who engage in these types of activities. We are traveling to Jabal al Lawz and the Split of Rock of Horeb – both of which do not have tourism and medical infrastructure.

Major Changes

Destinations and the sites offered here can be withdrawn at any time by government restrictions and other reasons beyond our control. COVID blamed cancellations (or any of the new disease related creations and acts of war), postponements and such of any kind are not the responsibility of LP.
